## **BACKGROUND/EVALUATION**

The County requested proposals from qualified firms for the provision of Design Build Services for the Southwest Water Reclamation Facility Second Cloth Media Filter project to include site work, survey, engineering design, and construction services under a single prime contract with a guaranteed maximum price (GMP). The Design Builder will provide all labor, materials, and equipment for the design and construction of the conversion of an existing sand filter to a new cloth media filter, including system modifications to address the new media system, demolition and removal of the of the existing media system, upgrades to the SCADA system, and all associated appurtenances necessary for a complete and functional system.

The solicitation was advertised on the Manatee County website and Periscope S2G. It was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce and the Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce for release to its members, and in the Bradenton Herald and Tempo News newspapers.
