## **QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:**

## Q1. Can the County provide tentative quantity estimates for the work?

R1. Yes, these will be provided in a future Addendum.

## Q2. It is our understanding that the roadway plans are at 90% design, will the county be willing to share these plans with interested proposers?

R2. Yes, these will be provided in a future Addendum.

## Q3. Will FPL allow an option of Contractor relocations of their facilities?

R3. This would be the responsibility of the CMAR to negotiate with FPL on available options.

## Q4. Exhibit 3 & 4 provided great plan views, can some typical sections, or any updated design information also be provided?

R4. Yes, these will be provided in a future Addendum.

## Q5. The drainage improvements (ponds) will include the removal and proper disposal of the existing material, can this soil be reused elsewhere on site as fill? Is there any geotechnical information available?

R5. Yes, this will be provided in a future Addendum.

# Q6. Exhibit 3 & 4 indicated many right-of-way acquisitions needed for this project. These exhibits also indicated individual parcels. Is there an matrix tracking the status of these property acquisitions by parcel? In addition, please confirm that for the non-friendly takes, that the eminent domain process will not delay the project schedule.

R6. The ROW acquisition matrix will be supplied to the selected CMAR proposer after award. Eminent domain WILL impact the project schedule.

# Q7. It is our understanding that for the third-party utility owners, they will be required to relocate their utilities. How much coordination has already been completed with these utility owners, and is there an anticipated schedule for when these relocations will be completed?

R7. Manatee County has coordinated with third party utility owners during the design process however no relocation schedules exist, and it will be the CMAR responsibility to coordinate relocations during project construction.

## Q8. Conflicts with Manatee County owned utilities, and required relocations will be performed by the CMAR, please confirm.

R8. Yes, Manatee County owned utilities are pay items in the contract and will be CMAR obligations to relocate/construct.
