Dear John:

Upon your request, Karins Engineering Group, Inc. (KEG) attended the June 14, 2011 Information Conference and we offer the following Question & Answer Addendum:

1. Q: Will there be requirements for more than one mobilization?

A: There will be only one mobilization. The following is a sequence of the preliminary schedule.

Disconnect kitchen equipment - County

Remove kitchen equipment - Contractor

Drains - County (ballooning)

Move equipment into trailer - (Contractor to provide trailer or other means of dry storage)

Tile removal - if Prisoners (County to provide dumpster)

Tile removal – if Contractor (Contractor to provide dumpster)

Floor coating installation - Contractor

Drains - County (Reinstall Drains)

Replace kitchen equipment – Contractor shall replace equipment in same condition as removed, meaning replace fasteners or bolts (not all equipment going back and will be marked by County)

Reattach kitchen equipment - County

- 2. Q: What are the work days?
 - A: Area will be closed to traffic and area is open 24/7 to workers.
- 3. Q: How was the tile applied and what will the slope be?

A: Confirmation of the application of the tile is that the tile was placed on thin set over a mud bed. The mud bed thickness is unknown and is likely variable. The finish slope shall be 1/8" per foot and improve the current condition.

4. Q: Will there be a moisture test?

A: Moisture test per ASTM F1869 will not be done prior to bidding. The mud was found to be 100% saturated and water was still being placed on the concrete, therefore the ASTM F1869 would have been invalid. The tile and mud bed will need to be removed during demolition to the acceptable concrete substrate for placement of the sloping and repair

material. The contractor shall complete moisture test after contract is awarded after placement of sloping material. The moisture test shall show favorable results to apply the floor coating, and allow the concrete to dry if the moisture test is unfavorable and retest.

6. Q: Will refrigeration be shut off and how will drains be taken care of prior to demolition?

A: Refrigeration will be shut off and condensation from the lines will be controlled best as possible by county. County will contract a plumber to place balloon or other material to keep debris out of drains. This work shall be coordinated by the contractor, county, and plumber.

7. Q: Will the recess area in the dish room remain?

A: No the dish room will not remain. The area shall be adjusted to slope water to drains.

8. Q: Will a floor plan showing dimensions and drain locations?

A: A plan will be provided with dimensions, drain locations, and kitchen equipment list (See attached). It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to verify dimensions and quantities of materials.

- 9. Contract time shall be extended by 7 days for the Base bid and Alternate Bid with options.
- 10. Manatee County is reviewing the option of overseeing the responsibility for the removal and replacement of the kitchen equipment. Therefore, the deletion of Line Item 3 "removal and replacement of kitchen equipment" would be considered in the evaluation of the award to responsive bidder. To be considered responsive, Contractors are required to bid all items on the Quote/Bid Forms remove and replace the kitchen equipment.
