Q1. Is removal needed prior or are this brand-new buses?

- R1. Existing decals do not require removal as the wrap can be installed over. Existing decals that are safety related must not be covered.
- Q2. Is there an install Bay to use for installation?
- R2. Yes.
- Q3. How many will be available to wrap at a time?
- R3. One (1) to two (2) per day.

- Q10. Is there a covered section in which the installers will be able to work under?
- R10. Yes. Covered bus bays.
- Q11. What is the quantity of each of the varying lengths for the paratransit buses?

- Q12. What are the precise measurements of the paratransit buses for quoting the with the windows and door placements?

- Q13. What does the area look like where in the installers will be working?

- Q14. What is the timeframe on when these need to be completed? Meaning will they all need to be completed by a certain day, or when a PO comes in for a certain amount?

- Q20. Please confirm that Items #1 an #2 include production, installation and shipping
- R20. Refer to Exhibit 1, Scope of Service, section 1.02 Scope.
- Q21. Please note that the calculation of 'Unit Price Per Wrap' for Item #1 an #2 will be based on production (sq/ft coverage) and installation (number of hours). Consequently, it is not possible to calculate single firm, fixed price given the variable 'Ranging in length from 22 to 29 feet long with varying window configurations'. The potential resolutions are to state a baseline specification e.g. 22' length per window configuration shown in Exhibit 5 Paratransit Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic IFB No. 24-R084572AF OR provide details of all 36 paratransits so the bidder can calculate an average to be used as a baseline price for the sub-fleet of paratransits please confirm

- Q22. Will the successful bidder be able to recover additional costs if they are transparently demonstrated to the satisfaction of the County?

- Q23. Please can you provide the make, model, year, and length in fleet of the vehicles?

- Q24. Would a standard turnaround/schedule of thirty working days from receipt of final artwork to first installation be acceptable?

- Q25. What is the schedule for installations and removals, is there a fixed date by which the installations must be completed?

- Q26. Please confirm the County will provide the final artwork in high-resolution vector files (e.g. Adobe Illustrator) with PMS color codes and vector files for the images
- R26. The vendor and MCAT will agree on the final artwork.

- Q33. What is the mechanism to increase pricing after 1 year
- R33. This is at the discretion of the department.
- Q34. Please confirm that because Item #3 is an Hourly Charge, the County will be pay extra (unstated) fees for replacement material
- R34. Any additional fees will need to be approved by MCAT.
- Q35. Please confirm that the Extended Cost is calculated by multiplying 'Estimated Ouantity' and 'Unit Price Per Wrap'
- R35. Yes.
- Q36. Item #2 (reference page 50 "For Paratransit Buses, which have varying window and door configurations, the Contractor must obtain precise measurements to ensure accurate vinyl wrap designs.") is problematic because bidders are being asked to provide a fixed low bid price for a variable specification, request to change this to a specific length and window configuration

- R46. The buy America clause was included given the possibility of the contract as whole, exceeding the federal required threshold.
- Q47. Also page 39 and 44, please confirm neither Fly America nor Cargo Preference Requirements apply to this Bid
- R47. The buy America clause was included given the possibility of the contract as a whole, exceeding the federal required threshold.
- Q48. Paragraph B.20 ePAYABLES, does the County use Automated Clearing House (ACH) banking, or postal checks as alternatives to credit card payment?

- Q49. Please confirm that notaries can be located out of state?

- Q50. Please confirm that all insurance certificates are not required prior to award

- Q51. Please confirm Attachment C, E and F are the only forms requiring notarization
- R51. Refer to solicitation.

- Q52. Paragraph 1.01 Background Information, please advise the split between 36 Paratransit Buses, which range in length from 22 to 29 feet long e.g. how many per specific foot length
- R52. Refer to R4.
- Q53. Is this a unionized environment, is there a Labor Agreement for this project?
- R53. No.
- Q54. Please confirm that the contractor will be provided with a temperature-controlled bay above 15 degrees with access to power, light and water and 3 feet of surrounding working space.
- R54. Yes.
- O55. Please confirm the working hours at MCAT e.g. 24/7?
- R55. Refer to Exhibit 1, Scope of Service.
- Q56. How many bay(s) are available with power, light and temperature control
- R56. One (1).
- Q57. Is "open flame" (blow torches) permitted on site?
- R57. Yes.
- Q58. Can the vehicles be installed in a single batch? If not, what is the batch size?
- R58. Refer to R14.
- Q59. Please acknowledge manufacturer's limitations on the windows ('No warranty applies for film installed on windows, but 2 years expected durability')
- R59. MCAT acknowledges manufacture limitations.
- Q60. Because 3M only offer a 1-year vertical warranty and a predicted 3-year lifespan for perforated material, should vendors note an exception?
- R60. Yes.
- Q61. Paragraph 1.03 General Requirements, A Installation, point #6 "Installation of vinyl wraps must be completed in less than three (3) days. If more time is needed, approval must be obtained from MCAT." Please confirm this is three business days on-site duration not three days of scheduling
- R61. Yes, three (3) business days.
- Q62. Paragraph 1.03 General Requirements, B Removal, point #2 "Contractor will be required to remove all vinyl wrap and ensure that no paint will peel from the bus." although the contractor can follow industry guidelines it is not possible to guarantee paint will not peel, please state the consequences of peeling e.g. will the County repaint the affected area?
- R62. Yes.

- Q63. Paragraph 1.03 General Requirements, B Removal, point #4 "Removal of vinyl wraps must be completed in less than three (3) days. If more time is needed, approval must be obtained from MCAT." Please confirm this is three business days on-site duration not three days of scheduling

- Q64. Regarding the point A Installation and point B Removal, are these to happen backto-back, or should a delay or interruption be expected for bodywork repair?
- R64. If there is damage, this may delay wraps.
- Q65. Paragraph 1.04 Technical Requirements, part B B. Vision or Window Perforated Vinyl: request to substitute Clear Focus Classic Vue 8Mil 2 year with Avery do11060 over laminate with 3M perforated film IJ67 with hard laminate 8914 or equivalent film/hard laminate
- R65. No.
- Q66. Exhibit 4, 35 Foot Gillig Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic Please confirm a commercial wrap is required not a color change
- R66. Commercial wrap is required.
- Q67. Exhibit 4, 35 Foot Gillig Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic Please confirm bumpers and roof do not need to be covered
- R67. Bumpers and roof will not need to be wrapped.
- Q68. Exhibit 4, 35 Foot Gillig Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic There are no pictures of the front or back, please confirm these areas do not need to be covered
- R68. The back and sides will need to be wrapped.
- Q69. Exhibit 4, 35 Foot Gillig Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic If the back is to be covered please specify whether the back window is perforated or opaque
- R69. The Gillig buses do not have a back window.
- Q70. Exhibit 5, Paratransit Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic IFB No. 24-R084572AF Please confirm the base paint is white such that the white areas do not need to be covered with vinyl
- R70. White areas must be wrapped.
- Q71. Exhibit 5, Paratransit Bus Vinyl Wrap Design and Schematic IFB No. 24-R084572AF
 Please confirm bumpers and roof do not need to be covered
- R71. Refer to R67.
