The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a sole source contract with a value of \$34,200.00 with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. for the provision of ESRI Enterprise Advantage Program Learning and Service Credits.

#### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure ESRI Enterprise Advantage Program Learning and Service Credits from Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s).

On October 9, 2018 the County entered into an Enterprise License Agreement with ESRI, Inc. This agreement offers access to various training options and professional services. The ability to purchase additional learning and service credits at a fixed rate was negotiated as part of the Enterprise Agreement.

The County has standardized on ESRI products. ITS has requested purchase of the ESRI credits, which are not sold through third party resellers. There are no other companies that can fulfill the need for training on the Software included in the multiyear agreement with ESRI.

Any company that believes they can provide this good or service must provide, in writing, convincing technical data sufficient to support their position to the Manatee County Procurement Division at [purchasing@mymanatee.org](mailto:purchasing@mymanatee.org) no later than November 27, 2024 for evaluation and consideration.
