QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

- Q1. Will Manatee County officials consider an alternate approach that retrofits the new metal standing seam roof panel over the existing building (office area)?
- R1. FEMA requires like for like unless code changes are affected then we can bring up to code.
- Q2. Will there be another opportunity to do a site visit to verify current conditions?
- R2. A second meeting can be arranged
- Q3. Are there restrictions on set-up areas for staging of equipment?
- R3. The staging area will be determined by Transit staff to ensure that there are no restrictions on their operations.

Q4.	The RFP is unclear, is the entire roof to be replaced or only damaged areas. If only
	damaged area who is determining what SF to be replaced?

- R4 The IFBC is for 100% roof replacement with gutters, downspouts, and soffits.
- Q5. As above is all the insulation supposed to be replaced or only damaged or wet, and who determines SF?
- R5. Replace all insulation
- Q6. Is all the gutter supposed to be replaced?
- R6. Replace all gutters
- Q7. Are other manufacturers acceptable if the profile and material match the existing profile and material?
- R7. Provide submittal for approval
- Q8. Are there any badging requirements for on-site workers?
- R8. Badges will be provided.
- Q9. Will areas within the building be made available for any installation which requires man lifts in the building?
- R9. Yes approved schedules and special arrangements will need to be approved and scheduled with County staff
- Q10. Please define what kind of protective coating on panels, bare galvanized, galvalume, clear acrylic coating, painted?
- R10. At G001, 13 34 19, 2.2.A, delete 1-4 and replace it with the following:

Match existing. Per record shop drawings, roof panels are galvalume and trim is Kynar. Verify in the field. Colors to match existing.

- Q11. Please confirm whether the scope of work requires complete replacement of the entire existing metal roof system, including panels, insulation, fasteners, and associated components.
- R11. Entire Roofing system to be replaced
- Q12. Specifications indicate reinstallation of gutters and downspouts. For locations where gutters or downspouts are missing, should these be furnished and installed as part of the project?
- R12. Yes

Q13. Please provide additional information regarding the scope of work related to the Lightning Protection System.

R13. At G001, insert the following specification section:

SECTION 26 41 13 – LIGHTNING PROTECTION FOR REROOFING

PART 1 – GENERAL

- 1.1 SUMMARY
- Remove, protect, and reinstall the existing Lightning Protection System (LPS) to accommodate reroofing.
- Maintain or exceed the level of protection provided by the existing system.

1.2 PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

- LPS shall comply with NFPA 780, UL 96, and UL 96A as referenced by the Florida Building Code (2023).
- System shall be eligible for a UL Master Label or LPI-175 Certificate of Inspection upon completion.
- Maintain electrical continuity, required bonding, and grounding per NFPA 780 and NEC.
- Roof attachments shall be compatible with the new PEMB roof system and maintain roof warranty.

1.3 SUBMITTALS

- Documentation of existing LPS condition prior to removal (photo log).
- Product data for replacement components (UL-listed).
- Final inspection certificate (UL Master Label or LPI-175).
- As-built drawings showing conductor routing, air terminals, bonds, downleads, and electrode connections.

PART 2 – PRODUCTS

- Use only UL-listed lightning protection components.
- Materials shall match existing system (copper or aluminum) and avoid dissimilar-metal contact.
- Attachment hardware shall be stainless steel or otherwise corrosion-resistant, non-penetrating where possible, and compatible with the roof system.

PART 3 – EXECUTION

- Carefully remove and tag existing LPS components; protect during storage.
- Reinstall conductors, air terminals, and bonding in compliance with NFPA 780 and UL 96A.

- Provide bonds to building steel, rooftop equipment, piping, and other metallic bodies within bonding distance.
- Reconnect to grounding electrode system; supplement as required to achieve code compliance.
- Coordinate with roofing installer to ensure watertightness and maintain manufacturer's warranty.
- Arrange for third-party inspection and certification at completion.

Q14. Please clarify the warranty requirements for the new roof system, including duration and whether both manufacturer and contractor warranties are expected.

R14. Per 13 34 19, 1.5, provide a 20-year weathertightness warranty and a 25-year finish warranty for coatings. In addition, the roofing contractor shall provide a minimum 2-year workmanship warranty covering installation quality and correction of defects in labor or application.

Q15. Can I get a copy of the sign-in sheet?

R15. A copy of the sign in sheet is included with this Addendum.

Deleted items will be struck through, added or modified items will be <u>underlined</u>. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the IFBC.
