Henry Avenue, Tampa, FL 33610 for a total contract award of \$632,076.62. This contract award includes the Base Bid of \$593,966.62 and \$38,110.00 for Bid Alternate 1 through 3 (Option "A" 120 calendar days) and a subsequent execution of contract, payment / performance bonds and acceptance of insurance.

- The Work included in this contract consists of the furnishing and installation of a complete and operational Electrical System at the Manatee Convention and Visitors Bureau. The Work shall include, but is not limited to: The Conference Toilet Area, Conference Center, Arena Lobby, Arena Lighting and the Exterior of the Facility. Work is to be performed in accordance with the Drawings and Specifications provided with the Invitation for Bid. All ancillary work required to implement the full system are also indicated and included in the Drawings and were made a part of the Invitation for Bid.
- 07/15/2011 through 08/08/2011 Appropriate bid procedures were followed. Notice of Bid availability was broadcast through DemandStar, www.mymanagee.org, the Chamber of Commerce. Five (5) Supplemental Suppliers were inputted into the DemandStar website.

DemandStar notified 900 suppliers. Forty-one (41) bidders obtained copies of the bid from Onvia DemandStar. (Note: Onvia Website shows a redundancy of four (4) firms). Six firms (6) were from Manatee County, five (5) firms were from Sarasota County, eight (8) firms were from Hillsborough County, two (2) firms were from Pinellas County, three (3) firms were from Broward County, two (2) firms were from Lee County and one (1) firm each were from Brevard, Duval, Hernando, Martin, Marion, Orange and Seminole Counties. Four (4) firms from outside the state of Florida obtained copies of the bid.

- Of the six bids (6) received, three were from Hillsborough County and three (3) were from Sarasota County.

In a review of the responses of the bid opening for the Manatee County Convention Center Electrical Systems Remodeling Project, we have the following evaluation of the bids, and recommendation of award.

Background

On August 8, 2011, the closed submittals of bids were opened by Manatee County Government Purchasing agent. Six potential contractors submitted bids for the project with the results varying. The bids are outlined in the Bid Tabulation, attached, outlining the line item pricing, as well as adherence to the Invitation For Bid.

Bid Evaluation

While in the process of evaluating the submittals for the responsive, responsible bidders, each firm was evaluated on criteria based on previous completion of similar projects in Florida, and having the registrations and certifications to perform all tasks indicated on the construction documents and the Invitation For Bid, as deemed necessary by the State of Florida.

It is the opinion of Global MEP and Fire Engineering, Inc. that a company specifically suited for primarily electrical lighting and lighting control systems installations shall be listed by the State of Florida as an Electrical Contractor, and having performed this type

and size of contract work locally in order to be considered for this project. Also evaluated was the cost benefit of the bids provided and the Bid Alternates, based on conservative estimate for this construction project. We feel that the prices provided are in the ranges that were to be expected for this project.

As the Manatee Convention Center will be operational throughout the construction period, it is important that the awarded contractor be both familiar with Manatee County standards, personnel, and the facility.

In review of the bids, there were multiple calculation errors by multiple contractors bidding this project. We have provided a Bid Tabulation of the submitted bids, with noted calculation errors highlighted. The revised extended pricing has been used to total the Bid Sections, and total Bid Price, in accordance with Article 829 (mathematical errors updates). Based on our evaluation of the bids and the bidders, Global MEP and Fire recommends award to bidder Electrical Engineering Enterprises, Inc. of Tampa, Florida, for the base bid of \$593,966.62. We also feel it would be equitable to proceed with accepting Bid Alternates 1 through 3. We were not able to verify all the project references provided for similar work, however, we are familiar with this contractor's work in this facility. This contractor is currently serving Manatee County Government as the electrical sub-contractor for the mechanical systems replacement in this facility, and is quite familiar with the existing electrical systems. It is our belief that this contractor will be able to meet the requirements as indicated on the construction documents.

We have enclosed a Bid Tabulation, and a line item Bid Tabulation with the corrected values indicating updated values for your use.
