The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$216,000.00 with Alpha Omega Communications, LLC for the provision of Bi-Directional Amplified Cellular System.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Bi-Directional Amplified Cellular System from Alpha Omega Communications, LLC without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

Manatee County recently acquired a new building in Lakewood Ranch, revealed through comprehensive testing that insufficient cellular signal levels are hindering reliable business operations and emergency communications. To address this issue, they have opted to install a cutting-edge cellular BDA (bi-directional amplified) system provided by Alpha Omega Communications, LLC. This Comba BDA system ensures robust cellular coverage throughout the entire building, utilizing Off-Air signal sources and carrier signals distributed by Active Remote Units strategically placed in the suspended ceilings. With a solid track record of deploying successful BDA systems throughout the county, Alpha Omega Communications, LLC's expertise and familiarity with local carriers make them well-suited to implement the new system efficiently.
