BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Hydromatic S4N300M3/4-4D5 Pump and S3HRC300M3-2 Pump from Barney’s Pumps, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

The Utilities Department has standardized the use of KSB and/or Homa pumps supplied by Barney’s Pumps, Inc. The replacement with other pumps would require additional modifications to the station design and/or components resulting in a large cost to the County. Standardizing also reduces the number of spare parts required to be kept in inventory. No modifications will be needed for these pump replacements because they are replacing older Hydromatic pumps.
