BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Handtevy Mobile System from Handtevy without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s).

The Handtevy Mobile System is a pediatric emergency medical technology program designed to reduce dosing errors and improve clinical outcomes during high-stress life-saving interventions. The Medication Management Software is used to create customized medication, and equipment guides as reliable backup to the Handtevy Mobile platform that is currently in use at the County. As the only hybrid model offering both operational customization and technical integration, it permits EMS users to treat patients with speed and precision. The three-year comprehensive package includes unlimited software updates, integrated training modules, and dedicated support at a fixed rate that provides a long-term subscription value.
