The following question was asked during the onsite vendors visit: Page 10 third paragraph, "stating the NICE logger system will be upgraded with the next generation system".

Response: Manatee county will have to replace the NICE call logger. It could be included with the new radio system or with NG9-1-1. The new call logging system must be compatible with whatever NG 9-1-1 we consider as well as support an IP interface for both Motorola and Harris radio systems.

Question below were received via Email prior to the deadline

1. **Question:** Under Scope of Services B.04, the RFP itemizes the meetings the consultant would need to attend. Does the County require project management services throughout the implementation/construction of the Next Generation system as part of B.04?

Response: Manatee county will provide a Project Manager. The consultant will advise/work with the Project Manager.

2. **Question:** Has the County started preparing their GIS data for NG9-1-1? Have any comparisons and reconciliation been completed between the MSAG and GIS data?

Response: Manatee county has completed the initial comparison and is now in the process of reconciliation. We estimate about 15% of the reconciliation is complete.
