ACTION DESIRED

Authorization to award IFB #12-1100CD, Collection/Removal of Used Oil and Other Waste Products, to the responsive, responsible bidder meeting requirements with the best offer to the County, Howco Environmental Services, St. Petersburg, FL for the collection and proper disposal of used oil and non DOT regulated waste products from various locations in Manatee County; and execution of revenue generating agreement for an approximate net value to the County of \$18,600.00 per year.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION


- This annual agreement with two (2) consecutive one year automatic renewal periods provides for the Collection/Removal of Used Oil and other non DOT regulated waste products on an "As Required Basis" from various County fleet and utility facilities.
- The collection includes the proper handling, consolidation, storage, transportation and disposal activities involved with the removal of used oil and other non DOT regulated waste products.
- 10/12/2012 to 10/26/2012, appropriate bid procedures were followed. Notice of the Bid's availability was posted on the Manatee County website; broadcast to two hundred fifty one (251) prospective bidders on DemandStar; and sent directly to three (3) local firms, as defined by section 2-26-6(c) of the Manatee County Purchasing Code, via email. Three (3) bids were received.
- This contract also provides for revenue to be paid to the County for used oil as well as payments from the County for the non DOT regulated waste products.
- Howco Environmental Services made the best offer to be paid to the County.

SUMMARY Recommend award of IFB #12-1100CD, Collection/Removal of Used Oil and Other Waste Products to Howco Environmental Services, St. Petersburg, FL and execution of Revenue Generating Agreement for an estimated net amount of \$18,600.00 per year paid to the County.
