#### **EVALUATION RESULTS:**

The Evaluation Committee (the "Committee") convened on July 23, 2014 to review evaluation committee responsibilities, discuss member's availability for future meetings, and the Florida Sunshine Law as applicable to public meetings. The Evaluation Committee then proceeded to review each of the six (6) proposals for their responsiveness to the requirements of the RFP. As a result of the discussion, the Committee unanimously voted to short list the following three (3) firms for further consideration, specifically, (i) Hees & Associates, Inc., (ii) Karins Engineering Group, Inc., and, (iii) Stirling & Wilbur Engineering Group. At the concurrent Evaluation Committee meeting, the Committee decided to forego Oral Presentations and recommended multiple Intent to Negotiate awards for the aforementioned three (3) firms to the County Administrator.

Hees & Associates, Inc. Sarasota, FL – The firm demonstrated exceptional qualifications in their proposal. Their submitted proposal was both responsive and responsible, meeting all necessary criteria set forth in the RFP. With an office located in Sarasota, FL, Hees & Associates provides a full service structural engineering firm with expertise in public, commercial and residential structures as well as threshold experience. Hees & Associates, Inc. is also a Veteran Owned Small Business with four (4) employees on staff. Their past experience (with both Manatee County and other public entities) and previously completed projects directly correlate their ability to provide the services outlined in the RFP. Based on Hees & Associates, Inc. relative experience, the firm also has the ability to successfully complete larger projects if necessary.

Karins Engineering Group, Inc., Sarasota, FL – The firm demonstrated exceptional qualifications by means of their proposal. Their submitted proposal was both responsive and responsible, meeting all necessary criteria set forth in the RFP. Karins Engineering Group, Inc. has offices located in St. Petersburg, FL, Fort Lauderdale, FL, Naples/Fort Myers, FL and are headquartered in Sarasota, FL. They currently have thirty-eight (38) employees on staff between the four (4) locations with sixteen (16) located in Sarasota and six (6) in the St. Petersburg, FL office location. Based on the extensive list of past projects (with both Manatee County and other public entities) and key personnel experience, Karins Engineering Group, Inc. portrayed the ability to successfully complete the as required basis workload expected by the County. This was further indicated through the past five (5) year project workload portion.

Stirling & Wilbur Engineering Group, Sarasota, FL – The firm demonstrated exceptional qualifications through the means of their submitted proposal. Finding the proposal both responsive and responsible, Stirling & Wilbur Engineering Group further demonstrated their ability through their list of past projects. With an office in Sarasota, FL, Stirling & Wilbur Engineering Group has a staff of seven (7) including two (2) professional engineers, one (1) graduate engineer, one (1) CAD technician, one (1) general contractor (providing inspection services) and two (2) clerical staff. Stirling & Wilbur Engineering Group is also a "Local Business" in accordance with Manatee County Local Preference Law and Vendor Registration requirements. Past experience included multiple projects with different entities located in Manatee County, Sarasota County, Venice, FL and Longboat Key, FL, respectively.
