BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

The Manatee County Utilities Department and Public Safety Department have a need to acquire high speed, web-based emergency notification system services to alert the citizens of Manatee County should any type of public emergency arise. The Proposer will furnish a system meeting the technical specification defined, including all aspects of the scope such as system implementation, professional training, comprehensive documentation, system security and maintenance services.

EVALUATION RESULTS:

The Evaluation Committee convened on May 19, 2014 9:00 A.M. – 10:00 A.M. and determined that oral interviews would be required from the short listed firms Emergency Communication Net, Code Red, Ormond Beach, FL and Everbridge Inc., Glendale, CA.

The Evaluation Committee convened on June 23, 2014 9:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M. to hear Oral Presentations by the short listed firms Everbridge Inc. and Emergency Communication Network, Code Red.

The Evaluation Committee convened on July 2, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. to discuss the offers based on the oral interviews and stated requirements in the RFP, continuing the acquisition process determining a recommendation to the County Administrator.

Emergency Communication Net, Code Red, Ormond Beach, FL – The firm presented its capabilities in a clear and concise manner via their proposal and continued to show these capabilities during oral interviews. Of particular importance was; a lower cost that would over a five year period create a cost savings of \$100,000 for similar technology, a strong Florida county representation with verified references, an in state home office, and an expressed willingness to work with the County to meet our requirements and needs.

Everbridge Inc., Glendale, CA – The firm submitted an informative proposal detailing their qualifications, its oral presentation created an informative exchange of ideas and technical depth which included Mass Notification and Mobile Members. Everbridge is a respected company in the industry and while impressed with the firm’s qualifications it was evaluated second by the Evaluation Committee. Concerns raised by the Evaluation Committee included; the overall cost to the County compared to the higher ranked firm, time frame for record retention was only eighteen months, and system was not as user friendly as the recommended proposer.
