BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

- The project provides for a man-made basin seagrass habitat and complementary oyster reef habitat and construction of shell trails and pedestrian bridges at the Perico Preserve.

We have reviewed the bids and have created the bid tabulation summary for the above referenced project, which is attached.

Tampa Contracting Services, Inc. was the low bidder with a submitted Project Total Bid of \$795,623.40.

Based on our review of the bid information and supplemental information provided, Tampa Contracting Services, Inc. appears to be the lowest responsive and qualified bidder and therefore we recommend award of the contract for IFB #15-0490DC to Tampa Contracting Services, Inc. We note that responses to questions 3 and 11 of Attachment A – Bidder's Questionnaire appear to be incomplete or unclear; we recommend that Manatee County request clarification from Tampa Contracting Services, Inc. on these items, including names of officers, directors and state of incorporation, and a complete list of all subcontractors proposed for the project, including the structural engineer to be used for the pedestrian bridges.
