ADDENDUM # 2

Bidders are hereby notified that this Addendum shall be acknowledged on pages 0200-1 of the Bid Form and made a part of the above named bidding and contract documents. Please note that this Addendum includes revisions to the Bid Form pages.

The following items are issued to add to, modify, and clarify the bid and contract documents. These items shall have the same force and effect as the original bidding and contract documents, and cost involved shall be included in the bid prices. Bids to be submitted on the specified bid date, shall conform to the additions and revisions listed herein.

The deadline for questions was **October 12, 2009 at 2:00 PM.** This deadline had been established to maintain fair treatment of all potential bidders, while maintaining the expedited nature of the Economic Stimulus that the contracting of this work may achieve.

The followings questions/answers are a result of requests for clarifications. The answers to the questions have been provided by Mr. Brian Martineau, Public Works Department, Project Manager, Project Management Division.

Bidders:

Question 1:

Addendum #1 Bid form 0200-55 and 0200-56 is supposed to replace the ones in the bid. But they are for super pave asphalt Not Cold recycling and Hot in place asphalt. Please clarify.

Answer 1:

The intent of Addendum # 1, page 0200-55 and 0200-56 was not to replace the original Bid forms 0200-55 and 0200-56. Rather, the intent of Addendum # 1 page 0200-55 and 0200-56 was to provide for staging of quantities. The length of text in the change caused the overlap in page numbering.

To alleviate any confusion, revised bid forms have been issued and are attached, labeled Addendum #2, 0200-55A and 0200-56A. **Therefore, bidders shall submit Bid form pages 0200-1 through 0200-86 and also Bid form page 0200-55A and 0200-56A, as applicable.** Revised Bid form sheets are attached.

Question 2:

The quantity (staged) referenced is the heading for all three items, IV.50, IV.51 and IV.52.

Answer 2:

Answered in Addendum # 1.

Question 3:

Please provide information for the following on the bid forms. Section III Pavement Base Construction, Section 4 (Dirt Removal). Will this item be paid by the cubic yard truck measure or the cubic yard cross section measure? Will the item include leading and hauling the excess material from the job site?

Answer 3:

The item will be paid by cubic yard truck measure. Yes, this item will include leading and hauling the excess material from the job site. Your bid price shall reflect this.

Question 4:

Will the item III.5 Clearing and Grubbing be paid for the cubic yard or the square yard? Will the item include loading and hauling from the job site?

Answer 4:

Bid form item III.5 Clearing and Grubbing, page 0200-16, (Addendum # 2 attached), is amended to read cubic yard. Yes, contractor shall be responsible for all necessary hauling, furnishing equipment, equipment operation, **furnishing any areas required for disposal of debris** and the leveling of terrain. Your bid price shall reflect this.

Question 5:

Bid form item III.6 Final Dress will the item be paid by the cubic yard or the square yard?

Answer 5:

Bid form item III.6 Final Dress, page 0200-16, (Addendum # 2 attached), is amended to read square yard.

Question 6:

Bid form item III.8 Fill Dirt Placing, page 0200-18 original bidding documents, will the item be paid by the cubic yard truck measure or by the cubic yard cross section measure?

Answer 6:

The item is to be paid by the cubic yard truck measure; no modification to the bid form is required. Your bid price shall reflect this.

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Question 7:

The question about using adjusting rings for manhole and water valves adjustment was answered in the addendum by referring us to page 81 of the standard specifications. I agree that this does address the adjusting rings. This also specifies a concrete collar 12" minimum width and 12" minimum thickness to be poured around the valve boxes and manholes. I would just like to confirm that this is a requirement as I've seen most of the resurfacing jobs being done without these collars being installed when manholes are raised.

Answer 7:

To clarify, the spec. on page 81 specifies a concrete collar of 12" minimum is required, but rings along are acceptable and concrete collars will be on an as-required basis.


