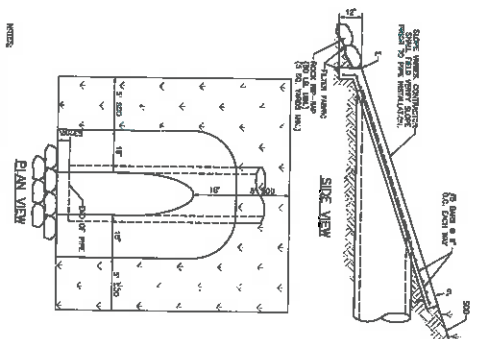
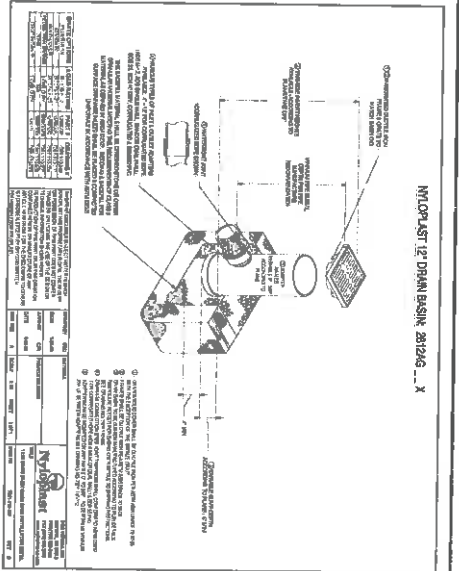
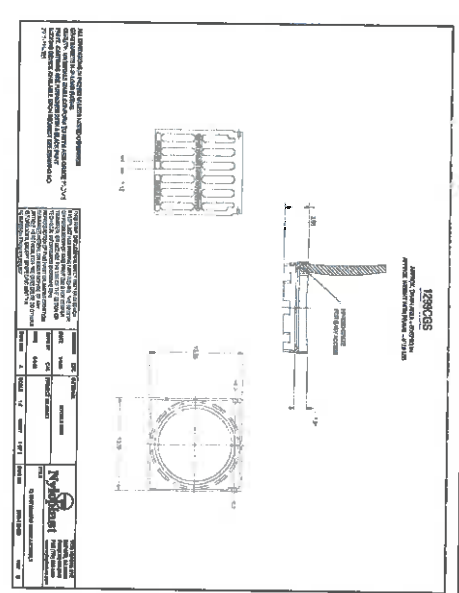
TYPICAL SHALLOW BOTTOM TREATMENT UNDERDRAIN

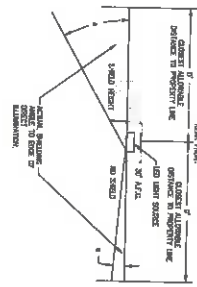


FIGURE A1/A2 (50) DIRECT ILLUMINATION PLOT

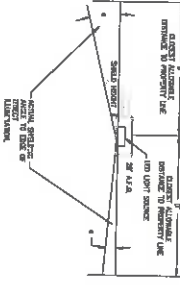


FIGURE A3 (20) DIRECT ILLUMINATION PLOT

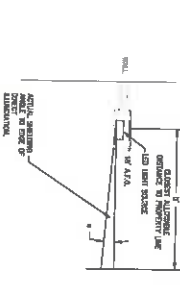


FIGURE C (10) DIRECT ILLUMINATION PLOT
