ADDENDUM 1**

The following addendum is issued to add to, modify, and/or clarify the above named solicitation documents. The items contained within this Addendum shall have the same force and effect as if contained within the first issued solicitation document and any cost involved shall be factored into the response. Quoters shall acknowledge receipt of this and any other addenda issued pursuant to this Request for Quotes (RFQ) in their quote submittal.


Question 1 - We assume that in addition to the removal and disposal of the old playground equipment that you would also want us to remove and dispose of the old rubber surfacing material as well. Is this correct?

Response 1 – Yes, the contractor shall remove and properly dispose of the old PIP surfacing material.

Question 2 - What type of substrate material was put down underneath the rubber? Can it be reused, or does a new substrate need to be provided?

Response 2 – The County believes that there is concrete underneath the rubber. There may be some work required to level the concrete if it is damaged while removing the old equipment. Contractors will need to take that into consideration and price accordingly.
