Quotes to be submitted on the specified quote date, shall conform to the additions and revisions listed herein.

Pond 67 A,B,C Removed canals from mow area. Pond 89 Removed canals from mow area.

The following questions have been presented by potential quoters:

1. QUESTION

Please clarify the specification: should the Tier 3 grass height be four (4) to eight (8) inches or should it be four (4) to six (6) inches?

Response: The requirement is that Tier 3 shall be maintained as a grass height of four (4) to six (6) inches.

2. QUESTION

Is the amount of spraying around the perimeter of all these retention ponds and fence lines acceptable to you and public works as they are?

Response: Yes, The current chemical pond maintenance contract requires the applicator to treat a band around the pond to the water level at the time of service. Because it has been dry water levels have dropped leaving a bare area between the high water and low water marks. This area should be moved or line wiped if needed up to the waters edge at the time of service.

3. QUESTION

Ponds 29 and 30 are in rough shape. Is there an alternative solution available to get these two ponds in serviceable condition?

Response: At the time of award, arrangements will be made to have inmate labor initially clean these two ponds. Before the first service event the County Contract Manager (CCM) and awarded contractor can meet on site and inspect the maintained area and at that time all maintenance including normal trash pickup will revert to the contractor. At any time if illegal dumping (large piles of waste outside of the scope of normal litter removal) or large debris such as tires, mattresses, furniture, etc. is discovered by the contractor, they should notify the CCM to arrange a site inspection and pickup.

4. QUESTION

A question about herbicide spraying in the ditches and swales; what if we do not have a licensed aquatic applicator on staff?

Response: To clarify on the use of herbicides to control vegetation. At any point if the contractor wishes to use herbicide to control vegetation along fence lines, around obstacles, or in the flow line of ditches and swales, the contractor must notify and receive approval from the CCM before application. Herbicides application is not mandatory and if the contractor does not wish to use them, the aforementioned areas can be maintained by line whipping, or hand pulling. All herbicide applications shall be performed by licensed personnel, in the case of fence line and other terrestrial applications a limited commercial applicators license will suffice, herbicide applications to ditches and swales shall require an aquatic applicators license.
