### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

#### PROJECT BACKGROUND:

The intent of this Learning Management System (LMS) Request For Proposal and resulting contract is to provide Manatee County Employees with more qualitative development options as well as control over time, place, path and pace in the delivery of just-in-time learning.

The proposed LMS shall provide an integrated, cloud-based learning management system. The desired system will support enterprise-wide administration, documentation, tracking, reporting, authoring and delivery of training. The proposed system shall also provide a repository for e-based content covering the gamut from off the shelf to custom developed solutions while addressing enterprise-wide skill building and compliance needs. Additionally, the desire is to create blended learning solutions to support the integration of eLearning with more traditional classroom content.

#### SOLICITATIONS:

The RFP was advertised on the Manatee County website, DemandStar, and was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce for release to its members. Five (5) proposals were received.

**EVALUATION RESULTS:**

Evaluation Committee Meeting #1 convened on March 1, 2017 for review and discussion of proposals. Prior to review there was as statement of RFP intent, desired results and the Committees responsibilities relative to the Sunshine Laws as applicable to public meetings. Upon thorough review and discussion based upon the RFP requirements it was decided that MaxIT and WestNet Learning would be short listed and invited to give a web based demonstration of their LMS product.

Evaluation Committee Meeting #2 convened on March 22, 2017 for interactive demonstrations. Both MaxIT and WestNet Learning presented as planned. Upon conclusion of the demonstrations, the Committee unanimously agreed that based on the RFP stated requirements WestNet Learning provided a better overall product.

MaxIT, Jacksonville, Florida gave a satisfactory presentation but seemed less prepared and their graphics and system technology appeared somewhat dated. Therefore, The Committee agreed to ask WestNet Learning to provide the Committee with a test system to allow for hands on manipulation and real time functionality.

WestNet Learning, Arvada, CO, presented its LMS product in a clear, concise manner that evidenced its technological capabilities while at the same time showing an easy to use system, thus evidencing the best value for the County.

Per Chairman's request, on March 23, 2017, WestNet Learning provided a link to a training system "Know and Meet Customer Needs".

Evaluation Committee Meeting #3 convened on April 4, 2017 to engage a hands-on systems capability that was driven by the stakeholder, Kevin Goncalo. Simplicity, clarity, flexibility of use were demonstrated and discussed as an invaluable tool to aid all County employees and management to enjoy the ease of learning, tracking requirements, reporting progress and an overall system that will be easier to manage. Upon completion of the hands-on exercise the Evaluation Committee unanimously agreed to request an Intent to Negotiate with WestNet.

**ESTIMATED COST OF SERVICES:** The estimated annual expenditure is \$19,000.
