We have reviewed the construction bids submitted for the 53rd Avenue West Lighting project. A bid tabulation summary has been prepared which shows a summary of all bidders and a verification of all mathematical calculations and as well as their references.

The low bidder is Riley Electric Company Inc. in Largo, Florida with a bid amount of \$551,985.85. Riley Electric Company provided references for previous similar work projects which were roadway street lighting with successful completion:

- City of Tarpon Springs – Riley Electric constructed decorative pole top street lighting on Tarpon Avenue from Spring Boulevard to Ring Avenue in downtown, which the City reported that Riley Electric met all requirements and was satisfied with their work.
- City of St Petersburg – Riley Electric has held a general open contract for the last six years to perform maintenance for street lighting, including new street lighting with load center installations and maintenance of decorative lighting. The City reported that Riley Electric has met all requirements, has been very responsive and is satisfied with their work.
