ACTION DESIRED

Authorization to award IFB #10-1230CD, Collection/Removal of Used Lead-Acid Batteries, to the most responsive, responsible bidder meeting requirements with the best offer to the County, Interstate Batteries of Sarasota, Sarasota, FL for the collection and proper disposal of used lead-acid batteries from the Manatee County Landfill; and execution of revenue generating agreement for approximately \$8200 per year.

ENABLING/REGULATING AUTHORITY

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

- This annual agreement with two (2) consecutive one year automatic renewal periods provides for the Collection/Removal of Used Lead-Acid Batteries on an "As Required Basis" that are stockpiled at the Manatee County Lena Road Landfill or other designated County facilities.
- The collection includes the proper handling, consolidation, storage, transportation and disposal activities involved with the removal of said batteries.
- 2/3/2010 to 2/16/2010, appropriate bid procedures were followed. Notice of the Bid's availability was posted on the Manatee Chamber of Commerce and Manatee County websites as well as sent directly to four (4) local firms, as defined by section 2-26-6(c) of the Manatee County Purchasing Code, via email. Three (3) bids were received.
- Although notified of the bid opportunity, two (4) Manatee County vendors chose not to respond.
- Interstate Batteries of Sarasota made the highest offer to be paid to the County at \$0.20 per pound.

SUMMARY

Recommend award of IFB #10-1230CD, Collection/Removal of Used Lead-Acid Batteries to Interstate Batteries of Sarasota, Sarasota, FL and execution of Revenue Generating Agreement in the amount of \$0.20 per pound for an estimated \$8200.00 per year paid to the County.
