QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

- Q1. Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (like, from India or Canada)
- R1. Refer to Section A.29, E-Verify. Additionally, all facets of service, including any on-line services must remain in the U.S. at all times.
- Q2. Whether we need to come over there for meetings?
- R2. Attending technical evaluation meetings related to this RFP is at the discretion of the Proposer. However, the successful Proposer will be required to attend meetings with the County in person.
- Q3. Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (like, from India or Canada)
- R3. Refer to Q1.
- Q4. Can we submit the proposals via email?
- R4. Refer to Section A.03, Submission of Proposals
- Q5. Are you wanting a company to assist in the planning and project management of a soon to be released installation project or are you wanting a company to produce and install digital signs and guidance?
- R5. Refer to Section B Scope of Work.

- Q6. There is mention of wanting three kiosks, are those to be parking access revenue control machines or an enclosed room for an attendant to occupy?
- R6. The machines are intended to be fully automated revenue monitoring and control machines.
- Q7. Who is the parking management entity on record for the Manatee County Administration Building Parking Garage currently?
- R7. The City of Bradenton.
- Q8. If there is an outside operator other than Manatee County, can you tell me when the contract will expire?
- R8. Manatee County intends to take over monitoring and control of the garage from the City of Bradenton upon completion of the project.
- Q9. What is the cost of monthly parking for a county employee to park at the garage?
- R9. Parking in the employee designated area is at no cost to county employees.
- Q10. Are there any other monthly parkers in the garage aside from the county employees and if so how man and what is their rate of monthly parking?
- R10. All spaces not designated for employee parking are considered public parking and are available on a monthly or hourly fee basis. The City of Bradenton presently controls the pricing and enforcement.
- Q11. Will the winner of this contract, set enforcement fees for violators? If not, what entity will administer and set those fees?
- R11. The parking enforcement fee violation cost and parking regulations are set by the Board of County Commissioners via ordinance.
- Q12. We would like to request architectural diagrams of the garage in electronic format.
- R12. Refer to Section A.28 Confidentiality of Security Related Records
