QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

- Q1. Would the wire for the vehicle detection on Number 72 be considered incidental to the work?
- R1. Use pay item #13 as an F&I pay item for all detection lead in cables.
- Q2. Would astro brackets be considered incidental to the work?
- R2. Pay item #59 would be used for each astro bracket assembly replacement. The description should include the term "mast arm mounting brackets".
- Q3. Can companies from outside USA (e.g. India or Canada) apply for this IFB?
- R.3 Yes. Provided IFB Section B Minimum Qualifications are met which requires interested bidders to be licensed in State of Florida.
- Q4. Please clarify whether we need to come over there for meetings?
- R.4 Yes. Any meetings, required for the Scope of Work defined in the IFB, will be mandatory and take place in Manatee County Florida, USA.

Q5. Can we perform the tasks (related to IFB) outside USA?

R.5 No. All the work will be performed in Manatee County Florida, USA.

Q6. Can we submit the proposals via email?

R6. No. The County does not currently allow proposals to be submitted via email.
