QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

- Q1. Referencing Section "D" Bid Attachments, Bid Attachment 1, Insurance and Bond Requirements, page 113, item 9, Builder's Risk Insurance is marked for the contractor to furnish. Will Builder's Risk Insurance be required, as it is not applicable to this project? Please clarify
- R1. Builders Risk Insurance is required for this solicitation.
- Q2. Referencing "Project Schedule" on page 4 of the "Special Provisions". The first sentence in the first paragraph states that "The contractor shall submit a preliminary construction schedule with the bid". A preliminary construction schedule is not pertinent to the submission of this bid. We are bidding on two different substantial completion dates, bid "A" and bid "B", at bid time this is all that matters. The language to provide a preliminary schedule with the bid needs to be removed.
- R2. The requirement for a preliminary construction schedule with the bid is deleted per this Addendum No. 1.
- Q3. Referencing page 18 of the "Special Provisions", the third and fourth paragraphs mention, "COMPLIANCE WITH THE SOUTHWEST FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENTDISTRICT (SWFWMD) STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AND DISCHARGE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS AND/OR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (DEP) DREDGE AND FILL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS
- Southwest Florida Water Management District Stormwater Management and Discharge permits or exemptions, if any, and/or a Department of Environmental Protection Dredge and Fill permit, if any, required for this project have been obtained by the County. The Contractor shall comply with the stipulations of the Permits or Exemptions as stated herein". I do not find the SWFWMD permit in the provided bid documents. If the contractor is to comply with the said permit, the permit needs to be provided as it may affect the contractors bid. Please advise.
- R3. The project Exemption Permit from Southwest Florida Water Management District is incorporated as Attachment 4 per this Addendum No.1.

- Q4. Referencing page 18 of the "Special Provisions", "Clarification of Specific Line Items". Second paragraph states, "Line item #7, Clearing & Grubbing shall follow FDOT Specifications 2017, and shall also include the removal of existing fence, all types, riprap, trees and bushes, existing pavement, and plugging of the existing artesian wells. There are no wells called out or shown on the plans. Are there any wells that will require plugging on this project? Please clarify. If there are any wells to be plugged, information regarding the diameter of casing and the depth of the well need to be provided.
- Q5. Referencing MOT: Will the contractor be allowed to shift the southbound traffic to the center gore areas and turn lanes to maintain two-way traffic following FDOT Series Index 600, to have accessibility to the south bound lane for construction purposes during daytime activities? Please advise.
- R5. Yes, in concept. Final MOT will require approval once submitted by the contractor that receives the award.
- Q6. Referencing MOT: Will the speed limit be allowed to be reduced through the work zone? Please clarify.
- R6. See response to Question 5 above.

R4. No wells are known to exist in the project area.

- Q7. Can consideration be made to include a bid item for Off-Duty Law Enforcement during hours of work? The high rate of speed along this roadway is a concern to the SAFETY of workers. Please advise.
- R7. Pay item for MOT on this project is on a lump sum basis. Bidders should include everything that is necessary for construction under this line item. Once the project is awarded, a schedule of values will be required to indicate the items that make up the lump sum for periodic payments.
- Q8. Referencing the Bid Form, Line Item No.5, Soil Tracking Prevention Device, w/ a qty. of 2. The plans do not call out where these are to be installed. Please clarify on the location of installation for this bid item or the intended use of this bid item.
- R8. Contractor to determine along with their approach to the project.
- Q9. Is there any livestock on the property adjacent to the project that needs to be taken into consideration when removing the existing barbed wire fence? Please advise.
- R9. Livestock may be on this track of land during construction.
- Q10. There is no Miscellaneous Asphalt called out for at the new proposed guardrail. Will Miscellaneous Asphalt be required at the proposed guardrail? If required a bid item for such needs to be added to the bid form. Please clarify
- R10. Pay item for Misc Asphalt has been added. Please see revised Bid Form and Plan Set attached to this Addendum No.1.
- Q11. What is the current estimate/budget for the CR675 Canal Piping Project?
- **R11.** The Engineers Estimate including contingency is approximately \$630,000.00.

NOTE: Items that are struck through are deleted. Items that are <u>underlined</u> have been added or changed. All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the 18-TA002744JP.

The District has reviewed the information you submitted for the project referenced above and has determined that an Environmental Resource Permit (ERP) **will not be required** for the proposed construction of a grassed, 20-foot-wide maintenance shoulder on the southwest side of existing County Road 675. The construction of the shoulder will necessitate the relocation of an adjacent drainage canal, as depicted on the submitted plan drawings. [Rule 62-330.051(4)(c), F.A.C.]

The information received by the District will be kept on file to support the District's determination regarding your application. This information is available for viewing or downloading through the District's Application and Permit Search Tools located at www.WaterMatters.org/permits.

The District's determination that your project does not require an ERP is only applicable pursuant to the statutes and rules in effect at the time the information was submitted and may not be valid in the event subsequent changes occur in the applicable rules and statutes. Additionally, this notification does not mean that the District has determined that your project is permanently exempt from permitting requirements. Any subsequent change you make in the project's operation may necessitate further evaluation or permitting by the District. Therefore, you are advised to contact the District before beginning the project and before beginning any activity which is not specifically described in your submittal. Your timely pursuit of this activity is encouraged to avoid any potential rule changes that could affect your request.

This letter constitutes notice of Intended Agency Action of the project referenced above. The District's action in this matter only becomes closed to future legal challenges from members of the public if such persons have been properly notified of the District's action and no person objects to the District's action within the prescribed period of time following the notification. The District does not publish notices of agency action. If you wish to limit the time within which a person who does not receive actual written notice from the District may request an administrative hearing regarding this action, you are strongly encouraged to publish, at your own expense, a notice of agency action in the legal advertisement section of a newspaper of general circulation in the county or counties where the activity will occur. Publishing notice of agency action will close the window for filing a petition for hearing. Legal requirements and

instructions for publishing notice of agency action, as well as a noticing form that can be used is available from the District's website at www.WaterMatters.org/permits/noticing. If you publish notice of agency action, a copy of the affidavit of publishing provided by the newspaper should be sent to the Regulation Division at the District Service Office that services this permit or other agency action, for retention in the File of Record for this agency action.

Notice of Rights

Administrative Hearing

- 1. You or any person whose substantial interests are or may be affected by the District's intended or proposed action may request an administrative hearing on that action by filing a written petition in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes (F.S.), Uniform Rules of Procedure Chapter 28-106, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and District Rule 40D-1.1010, F.A.C. Unless otherwise provided by law, a petition for administrative hearing must be filed with (received by) the District within 21 days of receipt of written notice of agency action. "Written notice" means either actual written notice, or newspaper publication of notice, that the District has taken or intends to take agency action. "Receipt of written notice" is deemed to be the fifth day after the date on which actual notice is deposited in the United States mail, if notice is mailed to you, or the date that actual notice is issued, if sent to you by electronic mail or delivered to you, or the date that notice is published in a newspaper, for those persons to whom the District does not provide actual notice.
- 2. Pursuant to Subsection 373.427(2)(c), F.S., for notices of intended or proposed agency action on a consolidated application for an environmental resource permit and use of sovereignty submerged lands concurrently reviewed by the District, a petition for administrative hearing must be filed with (received by) the District within 14 days of receipt of written notice.
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 62-532.430, F.A.C., for notices of intent to deny a well construction permit, a petition for administrative hearing must be filed with (received by) the District within 30 days of receipt of written notice of intent to deny.
- 4. Any person who receives written notice of an agency decision and who fails to file a written request for a hearing within 21 days of receipt or other period as required by law waives the right to request a hearing on such matters.
- 5. Mediation pursuant to Section 120.573, F.S., to settle an administrative dispute regarding District intended or proposed action is not available prior to the filing of a petition for hearing.
- 6. A request or petition for administrative hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Chapter 28-106, F.A.C.A petition for a hearing must: (1) explain how the substantial interests of each person requesting the hearing will be affected by the District's intended action or proposed action, (2) state all material facts disputed by the person requesting the hearing or state that there are no material facts in dispute, and (3) otherwise comply with Rules 28-106.201 and 28-106.301, F.A.C. Chapter 28-106, F.A.C., can be viewed at www.flrules.org or at the District's website at www.WaterMatters.org/permits/rules.
- 7. A petition for administrative hearing is deemed filed upon receipt of the complete petition by the District Agency Clerk at the District's Tampa Service Office during normal business hours, which are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding District holidays. Filings with the District Agency Clerk may be made by mail, hand-delivery or facsimile transfer (fax). The District does not accept petitions for administrative hearing by electronic mail. Mailed filings must be addressed to, and hand-delivered filings must be delivered to, the Agency Clerk, Southwest Florida Water Management District, 7601 US Hwy 301, Tampa, FL 33637-6759. Faxed filings must be transmitted to the District Agency Clerk at (813) 367-9776. Any petition not received during normal business hours shall be filed as of 8:00 a.m. on the next business day. The District's acceptance of faxed petitions for filing is subject to certain conditions set forth in the District's Statement of Agency Organization and Operation, available for viewing at www.WaterMatters.org/about.

Judicial Review

- 1. Pursuant to Sections 120.60(3) and 120.68, F.S., a party who is adversely affected by District action may seek judicial review of the District's action. Judicial review shall be sought in the Fifth District Court of Appeal or in the appellate district where a party resides or as otherwise provided by law.
- 2. All proceedings shall be instituted by filing an original notice of appeal with the District Agency Clerk within 30 days after the rendition of the order being appealed, and a copy of the notice of appeal, accompanied by any filing fees prescribed by law, with the clerk of the court, in accordance with Rules 9.110 and 9.190 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure (Fla. R. App. P.). Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P. 9.020(h), an order is rendered when a signed written order is filed with the clerk of the lower tribunal.


