**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Cope Notes text messaging platform from Cope Notes without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

Cope Notes provides a unique voluntary text messaging platform that will engage in push notifications to subscribers regarding the management of mental health issues such as depression and anxiety. This service also is in response to the potential stressors and impacts related to COVID-19 and the economy for the purpose of helping alleviate stress and improving the overall health and wellbeing of County employees. Although there are other text messaging platforms available, Cope Notes is best suited for Employee Health Benefits' overall goals and objectives.
