## Response to email questions from Westra Construction:

- 1. What size is the service at each lift station: The size of the existing service breaker for each lift station is called out in the specifications, starting on page 124.
- 2. What is the intent for the 300 vs 360 day period? Normal construction time is estimated at360 days. If the project is expedited, we expect that 300 days is possible at perhaps a higher cost.
- 3. This is a statement by Westra, not a question.
- 4. Section 00300-9 Trench Safety Act form? Not applicable to this project. The form must be submitted, geotechnical information is not available.
- 5. How many concrete test cylinders will be required at each site by the engineer? The specification calls for minimum 3000 psi concrete so the inspector will view the tickets, but no cyclinders are required.
- 6. Will the County require a silt fence? If there are no stockpiles of fill type material on the site, silt fence is not required.
- 7. How many gallons of fuel does each site require? See paragraph 2.04.2 A 2 of the specifications.
- 8. Spec page 23 Permanent power? This addresses any power required by the contractor for his own use in order to complete the installation.
- 9. Permit fees in bid? These costs are approximate and provided for consistency between bidders. As mentioned in the pre-bid meeting, the County will reimburse any direct permitting fees over and above this amount.
- 10. Is fencing applicable for this bid? There is no fencing in this bid.
- 11. How many door hangers will the County provide? One. Project Management will generate a sample, the contractor will make as many copies as needed.

- 12. Is there any limitation on any generator manufacturer that will meet the spec? As long as the generator meets the specifications, any manufacturer will be considered.
- 13. Enclosure color? Color was not specified, but pantone green is preferred both the enclosure and fuel tank are to be the same color.
- 14. Will the County require an engineered slab including the cost for a PE stamp? Per Hal Wolf of the Building Dept., if the slab has rebar in it (and it will), it will require a drawing or sketch of the rebar detail and an inspection prior to the concrete pour. The drawing does not have to be signed / sealed by an engineer.
- 15. Please specify a fire extinguisher enclosure: The County will review and approve or comment on the enclosure that the contractor submits. Two acceptable cabinets are the Thomas Model FEB-25 and the AmeraProducts SF-PC-105-20.
- 16. KNOX box locations: All sites with a diesel fuel tank will require a KNOX box.

### Response to Info conference question:

1. For the Utility feed change on LS 3-A, who is responsible for this work? The relocation work and coordination with the local utility to remove the aerial feed power drop and go with underground feed is the responsibility of the contractor.
