NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A SINGLE SOURCE CONTRACT

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$87,342.00 to Burgess and Niple, Inc. for the provision of Mitigation Compliance Monitoring for the Robinson Preserve Phase II – B Project.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Mitigation Compliance Monitoring from Burgess and Niple, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

- The Robinson Preserve Expansion Phase IIB project, managed by the Parks and Natural Resources Department, includes impacts to mangrove and seagrass habitats that require mitigation for those impacts in accordance with state and federal permit authorizations.
- The compliance monitoring is a permit requirement of FDEP. The monitoring period is five (5) years from the date of mitigation construction completion, which occurred in June 2021, and monitoring events are conducted annually for the mangrove and seagrass mitigation areas.
- Burgess and Niple, Inc. has extensive project specific knowledge, relevant relationships with regulatory agencies and a proven track record of successfully completing complex tasks in relation to mitigation compliance.
