BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

- Provides complete machine maintenance and chemical dispensing programs for chlorine and pH levels within the parameters of proper safety requirements and functionality;
- Provides fair and reasonable pricing, efficient services and response time as required.
- Poolsure is the current provider of chemical maintenance services for the County-owned and operated pools. While there may be other providers of these services, Poolsure’s institutional knowledge best aligns with the County’s goals and objectives.
