The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$146,852.00 to Carter and Verplanck-DXP for the provision of Flowserve pumps.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Flowserve pumps from Carter and Verplanck-DXP without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reasons:

The Utilities Department has established a standard of use of Flowserve pumps in water treatment processes. Carter and Verplanck-DXP, Tampa, Florida, is the only Flowserve OEM distributor in Florida. The Utilities Department and the Procurement Division have determined that Flowserve pumps, sourced from Carter and Verplanck-DXP, is in the County's best interest.
