**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure removal and replacement of a damaged custom sign located at Lakewood Ranch Park 5350 Lakewood Ranch Blvd. Bradenton, FL 34221 from Robson Corporation without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

Robson Corporation has been providing signs to Manatee County since 2009 giving them institutional knowledge of County practices and requirements. The custom signs created and maintained by Robson Corporation meets the regulations set forth by the county.

Procuring custom signs from Robson Corporation will ensure compatibility with the County’s existing signs and will ensure the County is meeting the required signage regulations. Robson Corporation’s signs have become the standard for the exterior signage in Manatee County.

A competitive solicitation process cannot reasonably be used, or, if used, will result in the costs of exterior signage throughout the county to be higher with an unknown design and compatibility outcome.
